FAMILY CHAMPION

This role reports to the Section Head, Family Services

Family Services exists to Empower urban poor families (B40 group) to be financially and emotionally resilient so that they can support a healthy environment at home for children to thrive and have access to quality education.

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Conduct and provide Family Protection (PRUKasih) services to GG identified communities.
2. Conduct family support (case intervention) to help families in need of assistance, provide relevant support to the targeted families.
3. Liaise with leaders of the community to co-organize family empowerment initiatives.
4. Build strong relationships through good follow up and communication with stakeholders such as relevant government bodies, NGOs, partners, schools, parents, clients and volunteers.
5. Project manage (organize) programs, projects, activities or relevant initiatives according to the needs of the community, reaching entire families.
6. Brief, motivate and engage volunteers and maintain a steady volunteer-base.
7. Conduct relevant research or field visits that contributes the development of the members in the community, whether for adults, teens, children or the entire family.
8. Be an active part of the GG staff team and actively seek opportunities of collaboration and synergies across departments.
9. Maintain and prepare necessary status and progress reports. Share and update monthly staff reports.

- Degree or Diploma holder. Experience in social work and Family social work is a plus.
- Strong organizational and administrative skills. Detailed and must be willing to do paper work and documentation when necessary.
